To check if vCenter Server has been licensed for VSA, you can go to Administration > License Manager and check the license status of the vCenter Server. The vCenter Server with license and VSA license counts will appear in the Summary page. If the VSA count is 0, that means the vCenter Server is not licensed for VSA. SSL mode.
