The predictors of functional outcome in cerebral palsy (CP) are not well understood. Some predictors (eg, Gross Motor Function Classification System level) are directly related to function, whereas others (eg, age at motor milestones) may simply reflect the age at which motor control is established. The objective of this study was to determine if the Maternal and Perinatal Severity score is an independent predictor of functional outcome in children with CP. A secondary analysis was performed on data

from the Cerebral Palsy Surveillance Network (CP-SN) for all children with CP who underwent a comprehensive assessment at initial assessment or who underwent a follow-up at 6 months after the initial CP-SN assessment. At the initial assessment, the MPS was obtained. At follow-up, a clinical examination was performed by a multidisciplinary team. The Pediatric Evaluation of Disability Inventory (PEDI) was administered to obtain an outcome measure of functional ability in a child with CP. The MPS was analyzed as a predictor of PEDI scores. Three hundred twenty-four children with CP were assessed at the initial assessment and 127 children at the follow-up visit. The mean MPS was 7.7 (\pm SD, 5.2).
