1. Technical Field The present disclosure generally relates to the field of integrated circuits (ICs).

2. Description of the Related Art Computing devices including microprocessors are often used for a wide variety of applications. Typically, a computing device has some type of memory for storing data, instructions, and other information related to a particular application. One type of memory, non-volatile memory, retains data stored in the memory even when power to the memory is turned off. For example, it is sometimes desirable to store certain parameters associated with a computing device in non-volatile memory, such as serial numbers and passwords, to prevent unauthorized access to the computing device. Serial numbers and passwords may be stored in such non-volatile memory to limit access to the computing device. Certain classes of non-volatile memory, referred to as two-dimensional (2D) memory or planar memory, may be less expensive than other classes of non-volatile memory. However, 2D memory has a relatively small memory capacity, limiting the amount of data that can be stored in a memory cell. Three-dimensional (3D) memory, sometimes referred to as memory with three dimensions, may allow for memory cells with more storage capacity. In an example of a 3D memory, a memory cell may be arranged at the intersection of three stacked layers of memory material (e.g., silicon, germanium, gallium arsenide, etc.). This memory, sometimes referred to as a three-dimensional (3D) cross-point memory, may store data in a memory cell by storing electric charge in traps that are buried at the intersection of the three layers.
