I am trying to download my login credentials on the remote sftp server and then upload those credentials into the local ssh sftp server to allow me to login to my machine using my credentials on the remote server using the SFTPClient. I've tried to do this using the following code: `string remoteUser = "user"; string remotePass = "pass"; SftpClient sftpClient = new SftpClient(this.localHost, this.localPort); sftpClient.Connect(remoteHost, remotePort); sftpClient.ChangeWorkingDirectory("/home/user"); sftpClient.ChangePassword(remoteUser, remotePass);` After having done this I'm able to login to the remote sftp server using the credentials that I have entered in Visual Studio. However, I am now unable to logout, as when I do I get the following exception: An exception of type 'System.IO.IOException' occurred in mscorlib.dll but was not handled in user code. Additional information: Could not open input stream for user "ldquouser" A: The problem was that the remote user account was marked "disabled" and when this was the case, any attempts to access this account caused the sftp client to throw this error. To overcome this, I used the following code to change the state of the disabled account: `sftpClient.ChangeUserInfo(remoteUser, true);`
